Fieldhouse Wood Floor – Rules

- 1. No pop, sport drinks, juices, coffee etc. allowed in the field house. Water will be allowed please be careful not to spill.
- 2. Popcorn & some candy will be allowed. All other foods, cooked or uncooked, are not allowed.
- 3. Only Approved non-marking shoes, such as tennis shoes, are allowed on the fieldhouse wood floor.
- 4. No shot putting allowed in the field house. The upper gym will be used for this.
- 5. Baseball/Softball batting cages must have mats on the gym surface.
- 6. Baseball/Softball teams must use "indoor" balls for infield practice. Pitchers and catchers will be allowed to use regulation balls for pitching and playing catch provided proper floor and wall protections are used.
- 7. A protective tarp must be used to cover the floor for major events (graduation, cultural fest, festival of India, dances etc.).
- 8. No motorized vehicles or any equipment that could cause damage is allowed on the wood floor.
- 9. No <u>athletic tape</u> to be used on the floor. Only approved "floor tape" is to be used on the wood floor and must be taken off the floor after each practice or competition.

Outside groups using the fieldhouse will be charged extra for cleanup if these rules are ignored. Outside groups will get one warning notice and the second notice will result in future events not approved.
